Admission Requirements for International Students

The following items are required as part of the application for admission to Saint Michael's Episcopal School:

School academic records for student for last 2 years

Official bank statement showing proof of funds available for tuition, fees and living expenses

I:20 Application and \$200.00 fee

Health and Immunization records for student

After admission, we require additional documentation:

Student Evaluation Forms (2) from teachers, coaches or minister

A completed Guardian Medical Power of Attorney Form for student (letter template on web site)

Proof of medical insurance for student during time at this school

TOEFL or English language exam results (recommended, but only if student has been tested)

Photo copy of student's visa and passport (done on arrival to school)

Thank you for your interest in Saint Michael's Episcopal School. Please understand that your child's acceptance and success at our school will depend upon admission test results as well as motivation and ability to apply him or herself to the studies required.

While we understand that native language is most comfortable and familiar for your child, we expect that English will be spoken while at school, and practiced when out of school as often as possible. Familiarity with understanding, listening to and speaking in English will enable your child to do well in classes and empower him or her socially. We at Saint Michael's (StMES) strongly encourage our High School students to go on to college, and the ability to converse and write well in English will vastly improve chances for acceptance and admission to the college of their choice. Because an ability to speak and understand some English is an enormous benefit, you may wish to enroll your child in English classes *before* your child's arrival to St. Michael's.

Please send the information necessary for your child's admission to us as soon as possible. Testing in Vocabulary, Reading Comprehension and Math to determine student's skill level will be done after arrival, so it is very important that we receive academic records ASAP.
